
Acoustic Privacy Panels
(minimum 3, same size.)



Step 1


Gather three Acoustic Privacy Panels and pair each panel up with two Brackets. Next, slide one (1) Bracket over the short end of each Acoustic Privacy Panel, like so.

After you've made sure that both Brackets are centered on each Acoustic Privacy Panel, press down firmly until the inside of the Brackets are flush with the Acoustic Privacy Panel's edge (this is easier to accomplish when panels are laid down flat) to secure Brackets in place.



Step 2


Arrange your panels side by side. Stagger them so that the middle panel is slightly higher than the outer two panels, lining up the holes with outside panels underneath the middle panel.



Step 3


At each junction along the top, insert one (1) M8x12 Screw through the top of the Bracket holes you aligned in the previous step, and insert one (1) M8 Flange nut on the other end to secure it.

Feet will be attached at each panel junction and at both ends to allow your panels to sit in a tri-fold configuration. First, thread one (1) M8 Flange Nut onto one (1) Foot. Insert the Foot into the bottom hole from underneath, and use a 2nd M8 Flange nut on the upper end to secure the assembly.



Step 4


Assemble your Center hinges by aligning two (2) Center hinge clips by their holes (one facing up and the other facing down). Insert a M3x8 screw from the top, and install a M3 Nylock nut from below and tighten. **Note:** Only two (2) Center hinges are required to create a tri-panel configuration. (For larger configurations see "Connecting More Assemblies" for more info).



Step 4

Prop your panel assembly up onto its feet, and rotate one of the panels to a 90 degree angle. Next, slide a Center hinge clip onto the inside of one (1) of the Acoustic Privacy Panels. Next, pull the other panel out slightly, (the panels can bend) and slide the other end of the Center hinge clip onto it.


Repeat this step with the second corner. These hinges help support and stabilize the panels in your Acoustic room divider.



Step 5

You're almost done. Stand the assembly up and place it where you want it in your work area, adjusting the height of the feet where necessary to keep the divider upright and stable.

Connecting More Assemblies




If you want your Divider to be wider than 3 panels, you can connect together with multiple sets of Acoustic Privacy Panels and Hardware found in this kit.

Use the additional M8x12 Screws and M8 Flange nuts to attach the top Bracket of one 3-Panel Acoustic Room Divider assembly to the top Bracket of the next Room divider assembly.

Use the additional Center hinge assembly to connect the end panels of both Room divider assemblies.

Finally, remove the end Foot from each assembly, and use one (1) Foot to connect both of the panel assemblies together.



Note: It's important that you stagger your panels as you assemble them. When connecting additional panels, keep this staggered pattern.

For example, if your first assembly is “under-over-under” you’ll want to connect an “over-under-over” assembly to that. This allows your dividers to balance ideally.

If you do not stagger the panels, it could lead to balance issues. For example: if one were built using a “under-over-over-over-over” configuration, then each panel will be moved up more and more until the divider would not be stable enough to stand.
